*SHARP News* is looking for a new editor to run SHARP in the Classroom for a period of up to 3 years. The ideal candidate will have a passion for pedagogy and experience teaching or facilitating workshops on book history subjects. The scope of this role will also include:

- **Soliciting materials**, working with contributors to revise submissions, editing final drafts, and coordinating with the Editor in Chief to publish contributions on our website.
- **Curating** relevant content and **recruiting** contributors, based on a thematic or chronological focus of the editors' choosing.
- **Collaborating** with the *SHARP News* social media editor for digital outreach, and other communications.

We welcome applications from independent scholars; scholars working in galleries, libraries, archives and museums; as well as academics in higher education (community colleges, liberal arts colleges, or universities). We especially encourage applications from early career researchers (including graduate students), and particularly from BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and people of color) individuals and women and gender minorities.
